

CINQUE TERRE AND BEYOND - 7 DAY TOUR



Lunigiana, Cinque Terre, Gulf of Poets, Portofino, Carrara

Cinque Terre are 18 kilometres of sheer rocky coastline in northern Italy, terraced hills and vineyards sloping steeply down to the sea. Five little villages are built into the rocks between the beach and the hills. Centuries old footpaths and mule tracks wind about 500 to 1,000 feet above the sea, leading through olive groves and vineyards, orchards and chestnut woods. Lunigiana is the region to the extreme north of the Tuscany, situated between Liguria and Emilia Romagna along the course of the river Magra and its confluents, but historically its borders were much wider.

Day 3: Cinque Terre Guided Tour

Small beaches between sheer cliffs and winding paths offer enchanting views.

Day 4: Gulf of Poets Guided Tour

The Gulf of Poets is a beautiful amphitheatre of hills and mountains forming a scenic backdrop. The high, jagged coastline hugs peaceful bays in protection against the wind, where enchanting little ancient towns take their stand.

Day 5: Portofino Guided Tour

Portofino and the Tigullio Gulf are symbols representing Italy throughout the world. The coast is a sequence of fashionable resorts with their marinas, pastel-coloured houses, first-rate sports facilities and the seductive atmosphere of the Dolce Vita.
