

# SICILY WONDERS - 7 DAY TOUR

## Day 1: Arrival in Palermo

Transfer to Hotel in Taormina.

## Day 2: Siracusa Guided Tour

The old town portion of Siracusa is located on Ortygia Island, separated by a canal from the mainland. The city is a tourist center, a fishing port, and a marketing center for agricultural products, particularly olive oil and citrus fruits.

## Day 3: Catania Guided Tour

To the south lies the most fertile area of the province used predominantly to grow vines. It runs along the river Simeto, an area of outstanding natural beauty.

## Day 4: Piazza Armerina and Agrigento Guided Tour

Morning walking tour of Piazza Armerina, a town made famous for its Roman mosaics in the Villa Romana del Casale. In the afternoon we continue to Agrigento with a guided tour of the Valley of the Temples, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the greatest legacies of ancient Greece. This parade of well-preserved Doric temples dates back to the 5th century BC.

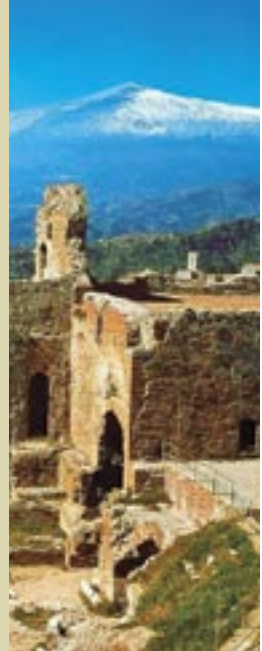
## Day 5: Ulmo Wine Estate & Monreale Abbey Tour

With its delightful setting and 16th century farmhouse, Ulmo is one of the most popular wineries for guided visits and tastings. In the afternoon we continue to Monreale, a small town overlooking the Oreto River valley and the famous "Conca d'Oro". Here we visit the Cathedral that stands on the edge of the historical centre.

## Day 6: Palermo Guided Tour
